The Legislature finds that it is a public necessity that the home addresses, telephone numbers, dates of 307 308 birth, and photographs of current or former commissioners of the 309 Florida Commission on Offender Review, previously known as the 310 Florida Parole Commission, and the personnel of the commission 311 whose duties include investigating, holding hearings, and making findings regarding violations of conditions of release be made 312 313 exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and s. 24(a), 314 Article I of the state Constitution. The Legislature further finds that it is a public necessity that the names, home 315 316 addresses, telephone numbers, dates of birth, and places of 317 employment of the spouses and children of the commissioners and 318 personnel, and the names and locations of schools and day care 319 facilities attended by the children of the commissioners and 320 personnel be made exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Article 321 I of the State Constitution. The Legislature finds that the 322 release of such personal identifying and location information could place these commissioners and personnel, and their family 323 324 members, in danger of physical and emotional harm from 325 disgruntled individuals who have had a contentious reaction to

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actions taken by the commissioners and personnel. The
Legislature further finds that the harm that may result from the
release of such personal identifying and location information
outweighs any public benefit that may be derived from the
disclosure of the information.
Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020.

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
