If such security can be established, the department 21 shall adopt rules to authorize a supervisor of elections to 2.2 accept from an overseas voter, including uniformed and civilian 23 overseas absentee voters, a request for an absentee ballot or a voted absentee ballot by secure facsimile machine transmission 24 or other secure electronic means.
