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(a) As used in this subsection, the term "emergency order" means an order or ordinance issued or enacted by a political subdivision in response to an emergency pursuant to this chapter or chapter 381 that limits the rights or liberties of individuals or businesses within the political subdivision.

- (b) It is the intent of the Legislature to minimize the negative effects of an emergency order issued by a political subdivision. Notwithstanding any other law, an emergency order issued by a political subdivision must be narrowly tailored to serve a compelling public health or safety purpose. Any such emergency order must be limited in duration, applicability, and scope in order to reduce any infringement on individual liberty to the greatest extent possible.
- (c) 1. An emergency order automatically expires 7 days after issuance but may be extended, as necessary, in 7-day increments for a total duration of not more than 42 days.
- 2. An emergency order may be extended only upon a majority vote of the governing body of the political subdivision approving the extension. The governing body may convene and vote remotely through electronic means for the sole purpose of extending an emergency order under this paragraph. The order extending the emergency order shall recite the circumstances requiring remote convening and voting, the method or methods of electronic means used to convene and vote, and the governing body's finding of necessity to convene and vote by electronic

52	(d) The Governor, or the Legislature by concurrent
53	resolution, may at any time invalidate an emergency order issued
54	by a political subdivision if the Governor or Legislature
55	determines that such order unnecessarily restricts individual

57	(e) Upon the expiration of an emergency order, a political
58	subdivision may not issue a substantially similar order.
59	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
