

1 A bill to be entitled
 2 An act relating to specialty license plates; amending
 3 s. 320.08056, F.S.; establishing an annual use fee for
 4 the Ducks Unlimited license plate; amending s.
 5 320.08058, F.S.; revising the design of the Lighthouse
 6 Association license plate; requiring the Department of
 7 Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to develop a Ducks
 8 Unlimited license plate; providing for distribution
 9 and use of fees collected from the sale of the plates;
 10 providing an effective date.

12 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

14 Section 1. Paragraph (ffff) is added to subsection (4) of
 15 section 320.08056, Florida Statutes, to read:

16 320.08056 Specialty license plates.—

17 (4) The following license plate annual use fees shall be
 18 collected for the appropriate specialty license plates:

19 (ffff) Ducks Unlimited license plate, \$25.

20 Section 2. Paragraph (a) of subsection (65) of section
 21 320.08058, Florida Statutes, is amended, and subsection (84) is
 22 added to that section, to read:

23 320.08058 Specialty license plates.—

24 (65) LIGHTHOUSE ASSOCIATION LICENSE PLATES.—

25 (a) The department shall develop a Lighthouse Association

26 license plate as provided in this section. The word "Florida"
 27 must appear at the top of the plate, and the words
 28 "SaveOurLighthouses.org ~~Visit Our Lights~~" must appear at the
 29 bottom of the plate.

30 (84) DUCKS UNLIMITED LICENSE PLATES.-

31 (a) The department shall develop a Ducks Unlimited license
 32 plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. Ducks
 33 Unlimited license plates must bear the colors and design
 34 approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at
 35 the top of the plate, and the words "Conserving Florida
 36 Wetlands" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

37 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
 38 be distributed to Ducks Unlimited, Inc., a nonprofit corporation
 39 under s. 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, to be used as
 40 follows:

41 1. Up to 5 percent may be used for administrative costs
 42 and marketing of the plate.

43 2. A minimum of 95 percent shall be used in Florida to
 44 support the mission and efforts of Ducks Unlimited, Inc., to
 45 conserve, restore, and manage Florida's wetlands and associated
 46 habitats for the benefit of waterfowl, other wildlife, and
 47 people.

48 Section 3. This act shall take effect October 1, 2017.
