22	opening remarks, if requested by the school, using the public
23	address system at the event. Such remarks may not be longer than
24	2 minutes per school. The athletic association may not control,
25	monitor, or review the content of the opening remarks and may

26	not control the school's choice of speaker. Before the opening
27	remarks, an announcement must be made that the content of any
28	opening remarks by a participating school are not endorsed by
29	and do not reflect the views and opinions of the athletic
30	association. The decision to allow opening remarks before
31	regular season contests is at the discretion of each school.
32	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
