27 jurisdiction for use in a criminal investigation. The release of 28 the property to the custody of the law enforcement officer is not considered a waiver or release of the secondhand dealer's 29 rights or interest in the property. Upon completion of the 30 31 criminal proceeding, the property must be returned to the 32 secondhand dealer unless the court orders other disposition. 33 When such other disposition is ordered, the court shall 34 additionally order the person from whom the secondhand dealer 35 acquired the property to pay restitution to the secondhand 36 dealer in the amount that the secondhand dealer paid for the 37 property together with reasonable attorney's fees and costs. 38 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
