Section 1. Subsection (15) is added to section 455.213, Florida Statutes, to read:

455.213 General licensing provisions.-

department shall waive 50 percent of the initial licensing fee for an applicant applying for an initial license for a profession under this chapter, with such waiver limited to a maximum of \$200 per year per license. The department shall waive 50 percent of a licensee's license renewal fee for a profession under this chapter, with such waiver limited to a maximum of \$200 per year per license. Such fee waivers shall not include any applicable unlicensed activity or background check fees. This subsection expires July 1, 2025.

Section 2. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, the sum of \$50
