Section 1. Notwithstanding s. 316.003(53), s. 316.006(2), s. 316.640(3), Florida Statutes, or any other provision of chapter 316, Florida Statutes, to the contrary, moving traffic violations may be enforced in any municipality within Broward County if traffic control signage meets Department of Transportation standards, regardless of whether the roadway complies with other department standards that do not affect such moving traffic violations, such as standards regarding roadway width and the existence of speed bumps or other traffic-calming devices.
