House Joint Resolution

A joint resolution proposing an amendment to Section 4 of Article IV and the creation of a new section in Article XII of the State Constitution to provide for the election of the Commissioner of Energy and the inclusion of the commissioner as a member of the Cabinet.

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Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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That the following amendment to Section 4 of Article IV of the State Constitution and the creation of a new section in Article XII of the State Constitution are agreed to and shall be submitted to the electors of this state for approval or rejection at the next general election or at an earlier special election specifically authorized by law for that purpose:

ARTICLE IV

#### EXECUTIVE

## SECTION 4. Cabinet.-

- (a) There shall be a cabinet composed of an attorney general, a chief financial officer, and a commissioner of agriculture, and a commissioner of energy. In addition to the powers and duties specified herein, they shall exercise such powers and perform such duties as may be prescribed by law. In the event of a tie vote of the governor and cabinet, the side on which the governor voted shall be deemed to prevail.
- (b) The attorney general shall be the chief state legal officer. There is created in the office of the attorney general

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the position of statewide prosecutor. The statewide prosecutor shall have concurrent jurisdiction with the state attorneys to prosecute violations of criminal laws occurring or having occurred, in two or more judicial circuits as part of a related transaction, or when any such offense is affecting or has affected two or more judicial circuits as provided by general law. The statewide prosecutor shall be appointed by the attorney general from not fewer less than three persons nominated by the judicial nominating commission for the supreme court, or as otherwise provided by general law.

- (c) The chief financial officer shall serve as the chief fiscal officer of the state, and shall settle and approve accounts against the state, and shall keep all state funds and securities.
- (d) The commissioner of agriculture shall have supervision of matters pertaining to agriculture except as otherwise provided by law.
- (e) The commissioner of energy shall serve as the energy policy chief of the state and shall supervise energy matters as prescribed by law. The commissioner's duties shall include data collection, assessment, forecasting, and timely reporting on the effects of the state's energy policy on the state's job creation, economic development, public health, the natural environment, and energy security; the state's role in national security; and the costs, accessibility, and reliability of such energy for the people of the state. The commissioner shall use research and data from the state's universities, colleges, and schools and from individuals and companies to explore future

 $\underline{\text{(f)}}$  (e) The governor as chair, the chief financial officer, and the attorney general shall constitute the state board of administration, which shall succeed to all the power, control, and authority of the state board of administration established pursuant to Article IX, Section 16 of the Constitution of 1885, and which shall continue as a body at least for the life of Article XII, Section 9(c).

<u>(g) (f)</u> The governor as chair, the chief financial officer, the attorney general, and the commissioner of agriculture, and the commissioner of energy shall constitute the trustees of the internal improvement trust fund and the land acquisition trust fund as provided by law.

(h)(g) The governor as chair, the chief financial officer, the attorney general, and the commissioner of agriculture, and the commissioner of energy shall constitute the agency head of the Department of Law Enforcement.

#### ARTICLE XII

#### SCHEDULE

Commissioner of energy.—The amendment to Section 4 of
Article IV providing for the election of a commissioner of
energy as a member of the cabinet shall take effect January 3,
2017, but shall govern with respect to the qualifying for and
the holding of the election for the commissioner of energy in
2016.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following statement be placed on the ballot:

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### ARTICLE XII

COMPOSITION OF CABINET; COMMISSIONER OF ENERGY.—Proposing an amendment to the State Constitution to create a statewide elected Commissioner of Energy; to require the commissioner to serve as the state's energy policy chief and supervise specific energy matters in the manner prescribed by law. The commissioner is included as a member of the Cabinet, the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund, the Land Acquisition Trust Fund, and a member of the head of the Department of Law Enforcement.

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
