Section 1003.4206, Florida Statutes, is created 17 to read: 18 19 1003.4206 Cyberbullying and cyberstalking awareness 20 instruction.— 21 Each district school board shall provide cyberbullying 22 and cyberstalking awareness instruction in all K-12 public 23 schools in the district during the third week in September each 24 year. The district school board shall designate the week as 25 "Cyberbullying and Cyberstalking Awareness Week." 26 (2) For purposes of this section, the term: 27 "Cyberbullying" means the transmission of any

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the malicious or willful intent to threaten, torment, abuse, or intimidate an individual.

- (b) "Cyberstalking" means engaging in a course of conduct to communicate, or to cause to be communicated, words, images, or language by or through the use of electronic mail or electronic communication, directed at a specific person, causing substantial emotional distress to that person and serving no legitimate purpose.
- (3) During Cyberbullying and Cyberstalking Awareness Week, students shall be provided intensive instruction to expand their knowledge, understanding, and awareness of cyberbullying and cyberstalking and the consequences of such actions. The instruction shall be integrated into the existing school curriculum in ways including, but not limited to, supplementing lesson plans, holding school assemblies, or providing other school-related activities. The instruction shall be delivered by qualified school personnel or by knowledgeable guest speakers.
- (4) The goals of cyberbullying and cyberstalking awareness instruction include:
- (a) Increased attention to identifying and preventing cyberbullying and cyberstalking.
- (b) Awareness of the serious consequences of cyberbullying or cyberstalking, including, but not limited to, the substantial emotional distress that cyberbullying or cyberstalking may cause and the civil and criminal penalties for incidents of cyberstalking.
- (c) Ways in which to respond to cyberbullying or cyberstalking, including reporting incidents of cyberbullying or

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cyberstalking to school officials.
(d) Awareness that incidents of cyberbullying or
cyberstalking which occur in school often continue to occur
after school hours.
Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012.

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
