General education curricula for associate in arts programs shall 18 be identified by each institution and, beginning with students 19 20 initially entering a Florida College System institution or state 21 university in 2014-2015 and thereafter, shall include 30 22 semester hours in the subject areas of communication, 23 mathematics, social sciences, humanities, and natural sciences, 24 and social sciences, including 6 semester hours of United States 25 history at the lower-division level. 26 (7)An associate in arts degree shall require no more than 27 60 semester hours of college credit and, beginning with students 28 initially entering a Florida College System institution or state

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university in 2014-2015 and thereafter, include 30 semester hours of general education coursework, including 6 semester <u>hours of United States history at the lower-division level</u>, and demonstration of competency in a foreign language pursuant to s. 1007.262. Except for college-preparatory coursework required pursuant to s. 1008.30, all required coursework shall count toward the associate in arts degree or the baccalaureate degree.

36 (8) A baccalaureate degree program shall require no more 37 than 120 semester hours of college credit and, beginning with students initially entering a Florida College System institution 38 39 or state university in 2014-2015 and thereafter, include 30 40 semester hours of general education coursework, including 6 semester hours of United States history at the lower-division 41 42 level, unless prior approval has been granted by the Board of 43 Governors for baccalaureate degree programs offered by state 44 universities and by the State Board of Education for 45 baccalaureate degree programs offered by Florida College System institutions. 46

47 (10)Students at state universities may request associate in arts certificates if they have successfully completed the 48 49 minimum requirements for the degree of associate in arts (A.A.). 50 The university must grant the student an associate in arts 51 degree if the student has successfully completed minimum 52 requirements for college-level communication and computation 53 skills adopted by the State Board of Education and 60 academic 54 semester hours or the equivalent within a degree program area 55 and, beginning with students initially entering a Florida 56 College System institution or state university in 2014-2015 and

58	courses in the subject areas of communication, mathematics,
59	social sciences, humanities, and natural sciences, and social
60	sciences, including 6 semester hours of United States history at
61	the lower-division level, consistent with the general education
