18	use telephone numbers submitted by licensees and
19	cardholders for specified purposes only; authorizing
20	the department to enter into contracts with private
21	entities for a specified purpose; prohibiting private
22	entities from storing, selling, or sharing personal
23	information collected from scanning the digital proofs
24	of driver licenses and identification cards; providing
25	an exception by authorizing individuals to consent to

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26	allow private entities to collect and store such
27	personal information; requiring that an individual is
28	informed what information is collected in such scans
29	and the purposes for which the information will be
30	used; authorizing private entities to manually collect
31	personal information from individuals under certain
32	circumstances; providing a civil penalty; providing
33	applicability; conforming provisions to changes made
34	by the act; amending s. 322.14, F.S.; conforming a
35	provision to changes made by the act; amending s.
36	322.15, F.S.; conforming a provision to changes made
37	by the act; requiring a licensee to present or submit
38	his or her printed driver license to a law enforcement
39	officer or an authorized representative of the
40	department under specified circumstances; reenacting
41	s. 322.121(2), F.S., relating to periodic
42	reexamination of all drivers, to incorporate the
43	amendment made to s. 322.15, F.S., in a reference

52	(1) As used in this section, the term:
53	(a) "Digital proof of driver license" means an electronic
54	credential viewable on an electronic credentialing system.
55	(b) "Digital proof of identification card" means an
56	electronic credential viewable on an electronic credentialing
57	system.
58	(c) "Electronic credentialing system" means a computer
59	system accessed using a computer, a cellular telephone, or any
60	other personal device which queries the department's driver
61	license and identification card records, displays or transmits
62	digital proofs of driver licenses and identification cards, and
63	verifies the authenticity of those electronic credentials.
64	(d) "Limited profile" means an electronic credential
65	containing some, but not all, of the information displayed on a
66	printed driver license or identification card.
67	(e) "Scanning" means obtaining data from a digital proof
68	of driver license or identification card in an electronic
69	format.
70	(2)(a) The department shall <u>establish</u> <del>begin to review and</del>
71	<del>prepare for the development of</del> a secure and uniform system for
72	issuing an optional digital proof of driver license <u>or</u>
73	identification card. The department may contract with one or
74	more private entities to develop <u>an electronic credentialing</u> <del>a</del>
75	digital proof of driver license system.

77	Internet protocol addresses, geolocation data, or other
78	information that describes the location, computer, computer

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101	(4)-(3) A person may not be issued a digital proof of
102	driver license or identification card until he or she satisfies
103	<u>all</u> has satisfied all of the requirements of this chapter for

105	identification card and has been issued a printed driver license
106	or identification card. The electronic credentialing system
107	must, upon each presentation of a digital driver license or

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Possesses a false digital proof of driver license or 151 (b) 152 identification card commits a misdemeanor of the second degree, 153 punishable as provided in s. 775.082. 154 Section 2. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 155 322.14, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 156 322.14 Licenses issued to drivers.-157 (1) (a) The department shall, upon successful completion of 158 all required examinations and payment of the required fee, issue to every qualified applicant a printed driver license that must 159 bear a color photograph or digital image of the licensee; the 160 name of the state; a distinguishing number assigned to the 161 162 licensee; and the licensee's full name, date of birth, and residence address; a brief description of the licensee, 163 including, but not limited to, the licensee's gender and height; 164 165 and the dates of issuance and expiration of the license. 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176 which must be fully legible with no portion of such license 177 faded, altered, mutilated, or defaced, in his or her immediate 178 possession at all times when operating a motor vehicle and shall 179 present or submit the same upon the demand of a law enforcement 180 officer or an authorized representative of the department. A 181 licensee may present or submit a digital proof of driver license 182 as provided in s. 322.032 in lieu of his or her printed a 183 physical driver license; however, if the law enforcement officer 184 or authorized representative of the department is unable to 185 immediately verify the digital proof of driver license, upon the demand of the law enforcement officer or authorized 186 187 representative of the department, the licensee must present or submit his or her printed driver license. 188
