The department shall establish a matching grant

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development organizations representing rural counties and communities for the purpose of building the professional capacity of regional economic development their organizations. Building the professional capacity of the regional economic development organizations includes the engagement and compensation of professional staff to develop, facilitate the delivery of, and directly provide needed economic development professional services, including technical assistance, education and leadership development, marketing and project recruitment, and other services deemed important for rural economic development. Such matching grants may also be used by an economic development organization to provide technical assistance to local governments, local economic development organizations, and existing and prospective businesses within the rural counties and communities that it serves. The department is authorized to approve, on an annual basis, grants to such regionally based economic development organizations. The maximum amount an organization may receive in any year will be \$50,000, or \$250,000 for each of the three regional economic development organizations serving the rural areas of opportunity as defined by executive order of the Governor. The three organizations include the North Florida Economic Development Partnership, Opportunity Florida, and Florida's Heartland \$150,000 in a rural area of opportunity recommended by the Rural Economic Development Initiative, Inc. and designated by the

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Governor, and must be matched each year by an equivalent amount of nonstate resources.

(3) The department may also contract for the development of an enterprise zone web portal or websites for each enterprise zone which will be used to market the program for job creation in disadvantaged urban and rural enterprise zones. Each enterprise zone web page should include downloadable links to state forms and information, as well as local message boards that help businesses and residents receive information concerning zone boundaries, job openings, zone programs, and neighborhood improvement activities.

(3)(4) The department may expend up to \$1 million \$750,000 each fiscal year from funds appropriated to the Rural Community Development Revolving Loan Fund for the purposes outlined in this section. The department may contract with Enterprise Florida, Inc., for the administration of the purposes specified in this section. Funds released to Enterprise Florida, Inc., for this purpose shall be released quarterly and shall be calculated based on the applications in process.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
