regular flow of vehicular traffic in violation of subsection (1) is not liable for such injury or death. In any action brought pursuant to this section, a person accused of violating subsection (1) or his or her representative has the burden of proving that he or she did not violate subsection (1) or that the injury or death was not unintentional.
