26 file such application within the specified time. In the case of 27 the sale of a motor vehicle by a licensed motor vehicle dealer 28 to a general purchaser who resides in another state or country, 29 the dealer is not required to apply for a certificate of title 30 for the motor vehicle; however, the dealer must transfer 31 ownership and reassign the certificate of title or 32 manufacturer's certificate of origin to the purchaser, and the 33 purchaser must sign an affidavit, as approved by the department, 34 that the purchaser will title and register the motor vehicle in 35 another state or country.
