1 House Resolution 2 A resolution designating March 2024 as "Colorectal 3 Cancer Awareness Month" in Florida. 4 5 WHEREAS, colorectal cancer is currently the second most 6 common cause of cancer-related death in the United States, and 7 WHEREAS, in 2023, approximately 153,020 people were 8 diagnosed with, and an estimated 52,550 people died from, 9 colorectal cancer in the United States, and WHEREAS, according to the Department of Health, when 10 11 adjusted for age, there were 33 colorectal cancer incidences per 100,000 Floridians in 2020, and 12 WHEREAS, regular screening, beginning at the age of 45, can 13 14 discover colorectal cancer in its earlier stages and may increase colorectal cancer survival rates, and 15 16 WHEREAS, increasing awareness and education concerning colorectal cancer can lead to significant progress in preventing 17 18 and overcoming the disease, as the majority of cases have proven 19 to be treatable and survivable, and 20 WHEREAS, educational campaigns and efforts can provide 21 information to the public on methods of prevention and screening 22 and can help with early detection of colorectal cancer, NOW, 23 THEREFORE, 24
