House Resolution

A resolution designating April 1, 2014, as "FSU Day" in the State of Florida.

WHEREAS, the main campus of Florida State University in Tallahassee is the oldest continuous site of higher education in Florida and chartered the state's first chapter of Phi Beta Kappa in 1935, and

WHEREAS, in 1994, Florida State University joined an elite group of the nation's top research universities, being designated a "Research I" institution by the Carnegie Foundation, and

WHEREAS, Florida State University offers graduate and undergraduate degrees in 314 programs within 16 independent colleges and schools, taught by a faculty of 2,140 members, which has included 13 National Academy of Sciences members and 6 Nobel Laureates, and

WHEREAS, the freshman class entering Florida State University in the fall of 2013 was one of the most academically accomplished freshman classes in the university's history, with an average grade point average of 4.0, an average SAT score of 1831, and an average composite ACT score of 28, as well as an average high school grade point average of 4.39, an average SAT score of 2,017, and an average composite ACT score of 31, among honors students, and

WHEREAS, for the second year in a row, Florida State
University was ranked by U.S. News & World Report as the
nation's "Most Efficient" university in producing the highest
possible education with limited or reduced resources, a ranking
that represents the university's excellence in spending on
student instruction, research, student services, and other
related expenditures, and

WHEREAS, in 2013, the Florida State University College of Medicine placed its 100th alumni physician in Florida, with 59 percent practicing primary care and 18 percent caring for patients from rural communities, and

WHEREAS, in 2010, the College of Medicine formally launched the Clinical Research Network, a statewide, collaborative, research network of faculty, community-based health care professionals, and researchers that supports clinical and translational research and provides for the treatment of patients from various backgrounds who accurately reflect Florida's diverse population, and

WHEREAS, the Florida State University football team completed a historic 2013 season by winning its third BCS National Championship and producing its third Heisman Trophy winner, quarterback Jameis Winston, and

WHEREAS, the college experience continues to enrich the lives of Florida State University students because of the university's long-standing promotion of racial, ethnic, and
