WHEREAS, the Florida Guardian ad Litem Program has worked tirelessly to enhance the lives of children and give them every opportunity to succeed, and

WHEREAS, Florida leads the nation in efforts to ensure that every abused or neglected child has a dedicated guardian ad litem, giving these children a voice in court, NOW, THEREFORE,
