Senators Ginn of the 47th and Dolezal of the 27th offered the following amendment \#1:

8 belts in passenger vehicles, is amended by revising subsection (a) as follows:
9 "(a) As used in this Code section, the term 'passenger vehicle' means every motor vehicle, including, but not limited to, pickup trucks, vans, and sport utility vehicles, and multipurpose off-highway vehicles, designed to carry 15 passengers or fewer and used for the transportation of persons; provided, however, that such term shall not include motorcycles; motor driven cycles; or off-road vehicles or pickup trucks being used by an owner, driver, or occupant 18 years of age or older in connection with agricultural pursuits that are usual and normal to the user's farming operation; and provided, further, that such term shall not include motor vehicles designed to carry 11 to 15 passengers which were manufactured prior to July 1, 2015, and which, as of such date, did not have manufacturer installed seat safety belts."

## SECTION 3.

20 By replacing lines 48 and 49 with the following:
21 (a) Except as provided for in subsection (b) of this Section, this Act shall become effective 22 on July 1, 2024.

23 (b) Section 3 of this Act shall become effective on January 1, 2025, and shall be applicable 24 to taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2025.

25 By replacing "SECTION 2." with "SECTION 4." and "SECTION 3." with "SECTION 5.".
