A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 51 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions for torts, so as to provide for a private right of action for damages suffered
- 3 due to sexual harassment under certain circumstances; to provide a definition; to provide for
- 4 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 1 of Title 51 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 8 provisions for torts, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 9 "51-1-56.
- 10 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'sexual harassment' means unwelcome sexual
- 11 <u>advances, requests for sexual favors, and other verbal or physical conduct of a sexual</u>
- 12 <u>nature.</u>
- 13 (b) When the remedies provided under Title VII of the federal Civil Rights Act of 1964
- do not apply, a private right of action is hereby created for the tort of sexual harassment
- when the sexual harassment explicitly or implicitly affects an individual's employment,
- unreasonably interferes with an individual's work performance, or creates an intimidating,
- 17 <u>hostile, or offensive work environment. When an individual suffers an economic loss or</u>
- personal injury, including emotional distress, as a result of sexual harassment, he or she
- may bring a civil action for the harm or damage sustained."

SECTION 2.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
