## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to courts, so as to
- 2 create the Student and School Safety Fund Commission; to provide for the membership,
- 3 appointment, terms, and duties of such commission; to create the Student and School Safety
- 4 Fund; to provide for the imposition, collection, and disposition of certain additional fees for
- 5 violation of certain criminal and traffic laws of this state to be used to implement and
- 6 enhance student and school safety measures; to provide for the priority of the fund when
- 7 partial payments are made; to provide for related matters; to provide for a contingent
- 8 effective date; to provide for automatic repeal under certain circumstances; to repeal
- 9 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

- 12 Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to courts, is amended in Code
- 13 Section 15-6-95, relating to priorities of distribution of fines, bond forfeitures, surcharges,
- 14 additional fees, and costs in cases of partial payments into the court, by deleting "and" at the
- end of paragraph (14), by replacing the period with "; and" at the end of paragraph (15), and
- 16 by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:
- 17 "(16) The amount provided for in Code Section 15-21-227 for the Student and School
- 18 <u>Safety Fund.</u>"

19 SECTION 2.

- 20 Said title is further amended in Chapter 21, relating to payment and disposition of fines and
- 21 forfeitures, by adding a new article to read as follows:

22 "ARTICLE 12

- 23 <u>15-21-220.</u>
- 24 This article is enacted pursuant to the authority of Article III, Section IX, Paragraph VI(p)
- 25 <u>of the Constitution of Georgia, which provision authorizes additional penalty assessments</u>
- 26 <u>in criminal and traffic cases and provides that the proceeds derived therefrom may be used</u>
- 27 <u>for the purpose of student and school safety measures.</u>
- 28 <u>15-21-221.</u>
- As used in this article, the term:
- 30 (1) 'Commission' means the Student and School Safety Fund Commission created in
- 31 <u>Code Section 15-21-222.</u>
- 32 (2) 'Student and School Safety Fund' means the fund created pursuant to Code
- 33 <u>Section 15-21-226.</u>
- 34 15-21-222.
- 35 (a) There is created the Student and School Safety Fund Commission, which is assigned
- 36 <u>to the Department of Public Safety for administrative purposes only, as prescribed in Code</u>
- 37 Section 50-4-3.
- 38 (b) The Student and School Safety Fund Commission shall consist of eight members who
- 39 <u>shall serve for terms of four years. The State Board of Education, the Georgia Emergency</u>
- 40 <u>Management and Homeland Security Agency, and the Department of Public Safety shall</u>
- 41 <u>each designate one member of the commission.</u> The remaining five members of the
- 42 <u>commission shall be appointed by the Governor. The Governor shall also establish initial</u>
- 43 terms of office for all members of the commission.
- 44 (c) In the event of death, resignation, disqualification, or removal for any reason of any
- 45 member of the commission, the vacancy shall be filled in the same manner as the original
- appointment, and the successor shall serve for the unexpired term.
- 47 (d) Membership on the commission does not constitute a public office, and no member
- 48 <u>shall be disqualified from holding public office by reason of his or her membership.</u>
- 49 (e) The Governor shall designate a chairperson of the commission from among the
- 50 members, which chairperson shall serve in that position at the pleasure of the Governor.
- 51 The commission may elect such other officers and committees as it considers appropriate.
- 52 (f) The commission, with the approval of the Governor, may employ such professional,
- 53 <u>technical</u>, or clerical personnel as deemed necessary to carry out the purposes of this
- 54 article.

- Members of the commission shall serve without compensation but shall receive the same
- 57 <u>expense allowance per day as that received by a member of the General Assembly for each</u>
- 58 day such member of the commission is in attendance at a meeting of such commission, plus
- 59 <u>either reimbursement for actual transportation costs while traveling by public carrier or the</u>
- same mileage allowance for use of a personal car in connection with such attendance as
- 61 <u>members of the General Assembly receive.</u> Such expense and travel allowance shall be
- 62 paid in lieu of any per diem, allowance, or other remuneration now received by any such
- 63 member for such attendance.
- 64 15-21-224.
- 65 (a) The commission shall do all of the following:
- 66 (1) Meet at such times and places as it shall determine necessary or convenient to
- 67 perform its duties. The commission shall also meet on the call of the chairperson or the
- 68 Governor;
- 69 (2) Maintain minutes of its meetings;
- 70 (3) Adopt rules and regulations for the transaction of its business;
- 71 (4) Accept applications for disbursements of available moneys from the fund;
- 72 (5) Maintain records of all expenditures of the commission, funds received as gifts and
- donations, and disbursements made; and
- 74 (6) Conform to the standards and requirements prescribed by the state accounting office
- pursuant to Chapter 5B of Title 50.
- 76 (b) The commission shall utilize existing state resources and staff of participating
- 77 <u>departments whenever practicable.</u>
- 78 <u>15-21-225.</u>
- 79 The commission may recommend to the Governor and the General Assembly changes in
- 80 state programs, statutes, policies, budgets, and standards relating to student and school
- 81 <u>safety.</u>
- 82 <u>15-21-226.</u>
- 83 (a) There is created the Student and School Safety Fund as a separate fund in the state
- 84 <u>treasury</u>. The state treasurer shall credit to the fund all amounts transferred to such fund
- and shall invest the fund moneys in the same manner as authorized for investing other
- 86 moneys in the state treasury.
- 87 (b) The commission may authorize the disbursement of available funds from moneys
- appropriated to the commission by the General Assembly for purposes of implementing

and enhancing student and school safety measures, including, but not limited to, security
 related devices and equipment, training of school personnel, and school resource officers.

- 91 <u>15-21-227.</u>
- 92 (a) In every case in which any state court, probate court, juvenile court, police, recorder's,
- 93 or mayor's court, municipal court, magistrate court, or superior court in this state shall
- 94 impose a fine, which shall be construed to include costs, for any criminal or quasi-criminal
- 95 offense against a criminal or traffic law, including civil traffic violations and violations of
- 96 <u>local criminal ordinances</u>, of this state or political subdivision thereof, there shall be
- 97 <u>imposed as an additional penalty a sum equal to the lesser of \$50.00 or 10 percent of the</u>
- 98 <u>original fine. In every case in which any state court, probate court, municipal court,</u>
- 99 <u>magistrate court, recorder's court, mayor's court, or superior court shall order the forfeiture</u>
- of bail or bond, the additional amounts provided for in this paragraph shall be paid over as
- provided in Code Section 15-21-228.
- 102 (b) Such sums shall be in addition to any amount required to be paid into any pension,
- annuity, or retirement fund under Title 47 or any other law and in addition to any other
- amounts provided for in this article.
- 105 <u>15-21-228.</u>
- 106 (a) The sums provided for in Code Section 15-21-227 shall be assessed and collected by
- the clerk or other court officer charged with the duty of collecting moneys from fines and
- shall be paid over by the last day of the following month to the Georgia Superior Court
- 109 <u>Clerks' Cooperative Authority for remittance to the Student and School Safety Fund</u>
- 110 Commission to be deposited into the Student and School Safety Fund.
- (b) Any person whose duty it is to collect and remit the sums provided for in this article
- who refuses to so remit shall be guilty of a misdemeanor."
- 113 **SECTION 3.**
- 114 This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2019, provided that a constitutional
- amendment is passed by the General Assembly and is ratified by the voters in the
- November, 2018, General Election amending the Constitution of Georgia to authorize the
- 117 General Assembly to provide specific funding to the Student and School Safety Fund. If
- such an amendment to the Constitution of Georgia is not so ratified, then this Act shall not
- become effective and shall stand repealed by operation of law on January 1, 2019.

- 121 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
