A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 33 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 liability of municipal corporations for acts or omissions, so as to revise provisions relating
- 3 to immunity of municipal corporations; to provide for related matters; to provide for an
- 4 effective date and applicability; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 33 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to liability of
- 8 municipal corporations for acts or omissions, is amended by revising Code Section 36-33-1,
- 9 relating to immunity from liability for damages, waiver of immunity by purchase of liability
- insurance, and liability for acts or omissions generally, as follows:
- 11 "36-33-1.
- 12 (a) Pursuant to Article I, Section II, Paragraph IX and Article IX, Section II, Paragraph IX
- of the Constitution of the State of Georgia, the General Assembly, except as provided in
- this Code section and in Chapter 92 of this title, declares it is the public policy of the State
- of Georgia that there is no waiver of the sovereign immunity of municipal corporations of
- the state, and such municipal corporations shall be immune from liability for damages to
- 17 <u>the same extent that counties are immune</u>. A municipal corporation shall not waive its
- immunity by the purchase of liability insurance, except as provided in Code Section
- 19 33-24-51 or 36-92-2, or unless the policy of insurance issued covers an occurrence for
- 20 which the defense of sovereign immunity is available, and then only to the extent of the
- 21 limits of such insurance policy. This subsection shall not be construed to affect any
- 22 litigation pending on July 1, 1986.
- 23 (b) Municipal corporations shall not be liable for failure to perform or for errors in
- 24 performing their legislative or judicial powers. For neglect to perform or improper or
- 25 unskillful performance of their ministerial duties, they shall be liable to the same extent that
- 26 counties are liable, and they shall be immune to the same extent that counties are immune."

27 **SECTION 2.**

- 28 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2014, and shall apply only to causes of action
- arising on or after that date.

30 **SECTION 3.**

31 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
