

House Bill 1029

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 general provisions regarding the General Assembly, so as to provide that members of the
3 General Assembly shall be limited to introducing a certain number of bills and privileged
4 resolutions at each legislative session; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
5 laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Chapter 1 of Title 28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
9 provisions regarding the General Assembly, is amended by adding a new Code section to
10 read as follows:

11 "28-1-18.

12 (a) Each member of the General Assembly shall be entitled to introduce not more than five
13 general bills or resolutions proposing constitutional amendments or having the effect of law
14 at each legislative session. There shall be no limitation the number of local and special
15 bills that may be introduced by a member.

16 (b) Each member of the General Assembly shall be entitled to introduce not more than
17 four privileged or invite resolutions at each legislative session.

18 (c) Bills or resolutions by a member in excess of the limits specified in subsections (a)
19 and (b) shall not be accepted for filing by the clerk of the House of Representatives or the
20 Secretary of the Senate."

21 **SECTION 2.**

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
