## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions regarding the General Assembly, so as to provide that members of the
- 3 General Assembly shall be limited to introducing a certain number of bills and privileged
- 4 resolutions at each legislative session; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 5 laws; and for other purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 1 of Title 28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 9 provisions regarding the General Assembly, is amended by adding a new Code section to
- 10 read as follows:
- 11 "<u>28-1-18.</u>
- 12 (a) Each member of the General Assembly shall be entitled to introduce not more than five
- 13 general bills or resolutions proposing constitutional amendments or having the effect of law
- 14 at each legislative session. There shall be no limitation the number of local and special
- bills that may be introduced by a member.
- 16 (b) Each member of the General Assembly shall be entitled to introduce not more than
- 17 <u>four privileged or invite resolutions at each legislative session.</u>
- 18 (c) Bills or resolutions by a member in excess of the limits specified in subsections (a)
- and (b) shall not be accepted for filing by the clerk of the House of Representatives or the
- 20 Secretary of the Senate."
- 21 SECTION 2.
- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
