A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 4 of Chapter 12 of Title 53 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to reformation, modification, division, consolidation, and termination of trusts, so
- 3 as to revise certain requirements for modifying or terminating a noncharitable irrevocable
- 4 trust; to provide for a definition; to provide for exceptions; to provide for related matters; to
- 5 provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7	SECTION 1.
8	Article 4 of Chapter 12 of Title 53 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
9	reformation, modification, division, consolidation, and termination of trusts, is amended by
10	revising subsection (c) of the Code Section 53-12-61, relating to power to direct
11	modification, consolidation, division, or termination, petition to modify or terminate
12	noncharitable irrevocable trust, proceeding to approve proposed modification or termination,
13	and distribution of trust property under order for termination, as follows:
14	"(c)(1) As used in this subsection, the term 'noncharitable trust' means a trust, no more
15	than 5 percent of the value of which is owned by charitable organizations.
16	(2) Except as provided for under paragraph (3) of this subsection, following Following
17	the settlor's death the court shall approve a petition to:
18	(1)(A) Modify a noncharitable irrevocable trust if all the beneficiaries consent, the
19	trustee has received notice of the proposed modification, and the court concludes that
20	modification is not inconsistent with any material purpose of such trust; and
21	(2)(B) Terminate a noncharitable irrevocable trust if all the beneficiaries consent, the
22	trustee has received notice of the proposed termination, and the court concludes that
23	continuance of such trust is not necessary to achieve any material purpose of such trust.
24	(3)(A) No modification described under paragraph (2) of this subsection may increase
25	the duties or liabilities, decrease the compensation, or otherwise affect the rights and

26	obligations of the trustee under the trust instrument without the trustee's consent thereto,
27	or upon a hearing with good cause shown.
28	(B) Nothing in this subsection may be deemed to waive or abrogate the other
29	provisions of this chapter, including, but not limited to, any requirement of any other
30	provision of this chapter that a petition be grated only for good cause shown."
31	SECTION 2.
32	This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
33	without such approval.
