A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act completely revising the laws relative to the governing authority of Chatham  
2 County, approved March 29, 1984 (Ga. L. 1984, p. 5050), as amended, so as to provide for  
3 an additional power of the board to censure members; to provide for related matters; to repeal  
4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act completely revising the laws relative to the governing authority of Chatham County,  
8 approved March 29, 1984 (Ga. L. 1984, p. 5050), as amended, is amended by adding a new  
9 subsection to Section 11 to read as follows:

10 "(e) The board of commissioners may, by unanimous vote of all members other than the  
11 member who is the subject of a vote pursuant to this subsection, adopt a resolution to  
12 censure any of its members for any action for which the board expresses disapproval. Such  
13 resolution shall serve only as notice and no penalty shall be attached thereto; provided,  
14 however, that any such resolution so adopted shall be entered into the minutes by the clerk  
15 of the board."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
