A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions relative to the General Assembly, so as to provide for rules of the House
- 3 of Representatives and the Senate governing the submission of written or prerecorded
- 4 audio-visual statements by members of the general public to standing committees regarding
- 5 legislation in possession of such standing committees; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
- 6 other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Chapter 1 of Title 28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 10 provisions relative to the General Assembly, is amended by adding a new Code section to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 "<u>28-1-18.</u>
- Not later than January 17, 2017, the House of Representatives and the Senate shall each
- 14 adopt rules governing the submission of written or prerecorded audio-visual statements by
- 15 members of the general public to standing committees of the House and Senate,
- respectively, regarding pending legislation which is in the possession of such standing
- 17 <u>committees. Such rules shall provide for procedures, format, length, means, and custody</u>
- of such submissions and for making such submissions available as promptly as feasible to
- members of the appropriate standing committees for their review."

SECTION 2.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
