A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 2 of Article 13 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to special provisions for motorcycles relative to uniform rules of the
- 3 road, so as to provide that motorcycles may overtake and pass in the same lane occupied by
- 4 the vehicle being overtaken under certain conditions; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Part 2 of Article 13 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 9 relating to special provisions for motorcycles relative to uniform rules of the road, is
- amended by revising Code Section 40-6-312, relating to operating a motorcycle on roadway
- 11 laned for traffic, as follows:
- 12 "40-6-312.
- 13 (a) All motorcycles are entitled to full use of a lane, and no motor vehicle shall be driven
- in such a manner as to deprive any motorcycle of the full use of a lane. This subsection
- shall not apply to motorcycles operated two abreast in a single lane.
- 16 (b) The operator of a motorcycle shall not may overtake and pass in the same lane
- occupied by the vehicle being overtaken <u>only if:</u>
- 18 (1) The vehicle being overtaken is stationary in traffic awaiting the change of a
- 19 <u>traffic-control signal;</u>
- 20 (2) The motorcycle is not traveling more than ten miles per hour; and
- 21 (3) The motorcycle is being maneuvered to be placed in front of stationary traffic or to
- 22 gain access to an adjacent turning lane.
- 23 (c) No person shall operate a motorcycle between lanes of traffic or between adjacent lines
- 24 or rows of vehicles.
- 25 (d)(c) Motorcycles shall not be operated more than two abreast in a single lane.

26 (e)(d) A person operating a motorcycle shall at all times keep his or her headlights and

- taillights illuminated.
- 28 (f)(e) Subsections The restrictions in subsection (b) and (c) of this Code section shall not
- apply to police officers in the performance of their official duties."

SECTION 2.

31 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
