A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 4 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to public assistance generally, so as to require legislative notification prior to any
- 3 request for a state plan amendment for an increase in eligibility or benefits above the
- 4 minimum requirements for temporary assistance for needy families or the supplemental
- 5 nutrition assistance program; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
- 6 for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Article 1 of Chapter 4 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 10 public assistance generally, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

- 12 (a) On and after July 1, 2016, neither the department, the board, nor any other
- 13 representative of this state shall submit any state plan amendment for approval to the
- 14 federal government for any increase in eligibility or benefits provided above the federally
- required minimum levels of participation for eligibility and benefits under the temporary
- assistance for needy families (TANF) program or the supplemental nutrition assistance
- 17 program (SNAP) without legislative notification. The legislative notification required
- 18 <u>under this subsection shall be by general Act of the General Assembly or the adoption of</u>
- 19 <u>a joint resolution of the General Assembly.</u>
- 20 (b) In the event that, as of June 30, 2016, any eligibility or benefits provided in this state
- 21 pursuant to the temporary assistance for needy families (TANF) program or the
- 22 <u>supplemental nutrition assistance program (SNAP) exceed the federally required minimum</u>
- 23 levels of participation, unless specifically authorized or required by state law in effect on
- 24 <u>such date, the appropriate state agency shall submit a state plan amendment no later than</u>
- 25 <u>July 31, 2016, to the appropriate federal agency to reduce such eligibility or benefits levels</u>
- 26 <u>to the federally required minimum levels of participation."</u>

27 **SECTION 2.**

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
