A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 31-2A-18 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 establishment of the Low THC oil patient registry, definitions, purpose, registration cards,
- 3 quarterly reports, and waiver forms, so as to add post traumatic stress disorder to the
- 4 conditions authorized for the use of low THC oil; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 5 purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

8 This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Have You Forgotten Act?"

9 SECTION 2.

- 10 Code Section 31-2A-18 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to establishment
- of the Low THC oil patient registry, definitions, purpose, registration cards, quarterly reports,
- 12 and waiver forms, is amended by revising paragraph (3) of subsection (a) as follows:
- 13 "(3) 'Condition' means:
- 14 (A) Cancer, when such diagnosis is end stage or the treatment produces related wasting
- illness, recalcitrant nausea, and vomiting;
- 16 (B) Amyotrophic lateral sclerosis, when such diagnosis is severe or end stage;
- 17 (C) Seizure disorders related to diagnosis of epilepsy or trauma related head injuries;
- 18 (D) Multiple sclerosis, when such diagnosis is severe or end stage;
- 19 (E) Crohn's disease;
- (F) Mitochondrial disease;
- 21 (G) Parkinson's disease, when such diagnosis is severe or end stage; or
- 22 (H) Sickle cell disease, when such diagnosis is severe or end stage; or
- 23 <u>(I) Post traumatic stress disorder."</u>

24 SECTION 3.

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
