A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 31-2A-18 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 establishment of the Low THC oil patient registry, definitions, purpose, registration cards,  
3 quarterly reports, and waiver forms, so as to add post traumatic stress disorder to the  
4 conditions authorized for the use of low THC oil; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other  
5 purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Have You Forgotten Act?"

9 **SECTION 2.**

10 Code Section 31-2A-18 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to establishment  
11 of the Low THC oil patient registry, definitions, purpose, registration cards, quarterly reports,  
12 and waiver forms, is amended by revising paragraph (3) of subsection (a) as follows:

13 "(3) 'Condition' means:

- 14 (A) Cancer, when such diagnosis is end stage or the treatment produces related wasting  
15 illness, recalcitrant nausea, and vomiting;
- 16 (B) Amyotrophic lateral sclerosis, when such diagnosis is severe or end stage;
- 17 (C) Seizure disorders related to diagnosis of epilepsy or trauma related head injuries;
- 18 (D) Multiple sclerosis, when such diagnosis is severe or end stage;
- 19 (E) Crohn's disease;
- 20 (F) Mitochondrial disease;
- 21 (G) Parkinson's disease, when such diagnosis is severe or end stage; ~~or~~
- 22 (H) Sickle cell disease, when such diagnosis is severe or end stage; or
- 23 (I) Post traumatic stress disorder."

**SECTION 3.**

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
