A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 16 of Title 9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Uniform

2 Civil Forfeiture Procedure Act," so as to provide that certain property is exempt from seizure

3 or forfeiture; to provide for a duty of the Attorney General; to provide for related matters; to

4 provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6	SECTION 1.
7	Chapter 16 of Title 9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Uniform Civil
8	Forfeiture Procedure Act," is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
9	" <u>9-16-6.1.</u>
10	The following shall be exempt from seizure or forfeiture under this chapter:
11	(1) Real property that is subject to a homestead exemption;
12	(2) Currency totaling \$541.00 or less; and
13	(3) A motor vehicle of less than \$5,000.00 in market value. The Attorney General shall
14	determine and identify the publications that shall be used for determining market value
15	under this paragraph."

17	This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
