## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Part 2 of Article 15 of Chapter 1 of Title 10 of the Official Code of Georgia 2 Annotated, relating to the "Fair Business Practices Act of 1975," so as to require cash 3 overpayments to be remitted by merchants in the form of store credit under certain 4 circumstances; to provide for a definition; to provide for exceptions; to provide for penalties 5 and remedies; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other 6 purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

## **SECTION 1.**

9 Part 2 of Article 15 of Chapter 1 of Title 10 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,

relating to the "Fair Business Practices Act of 1975," is amended by adding a new Codesection to read as follows:

12 "10-1-393.20.

13 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'merchant' means any person that offers goods,

14 wares, merchandise, or services for sale, excluding offers made online or entirely through

15 an automated machine, in this state to the public and shall include an employee of a

16 <u>merchant.</u>

- 17 (b) If a merchant does not have exact change to give a buyer for an overpayment for goods
- 18 and services paid for with cash, the merchant shall remit the amount of payment in excess
- 19 of the purchase price and sales tax to the buyer in the form of a store credit.
- 20 (c) The provisions of this Code section shall not apply to a merchant that:
- 21 (1) Is a sole proprietor;
- 22 (2) Is a business with only one employee; or
- 23 (3) Is at an event expected to attract 500 or more persons.
- 24 (d) Any merchant that violates any provision of this Code section shall be subject to the
- 25 penalties provided in this part.
- 26 (e) The rights and remedies provided for in this Code section are in addition to any other
- 27 rights and remedies provided by law."

## **SECTION 2.**

29 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
