A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Chapter 8 of Title 33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to fees
and taxes, so as require that a portion of the state insurance premium tax is sent to counties
in order to fund flood remediation programs; to provide for related matters; to repeal
conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.** 7 Chapter 8 of Title 33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to fees and taxes, 8 is amended by adding a new subsection to Code Section 33-8-4, relating to the amount and 9 method of computing the tax on insurance premiums, as follows: 10 "(d) It is the intention of the General Assembly that \$100 million of the proceeds of the tax 11 imposed under subsection (a) of this Code section shall be distributed on a pro rata basis 12 based on population to each county in this state. Such proceeds shall be used by the county 13 to fund and develop flood risk reduction programs provided for in subparagraph (a)(1)(E)of Code Section 33-8-8.3." 14
