## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 45-16-27 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 when inquest is to be held, special situations, coroner's fee, issuance of subpoenas for books,
- 3 records, or papers, cost of copying, and limited disclosure of photographs, so as to provide
- 4 that any person alleging elder abuse may demand a coroner's inquest within 30 days after a
- 5 death; to provide that a coroner may, but is not required to, hold an inquest; to repeal
- 6 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Code Section 45-16-27 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to when inquest
- 10 is to be held, special situations, coroner's fee, issuance of subpoenas for books, records, or
- 11 papers, cost of copying, and limited disclosure of photographs, is amended by revising
- 12 subparagraph (a)(1)(C) as follows:
- 13 "(C) When no demand for an inquest is made within 30 days after the filing of the
- death certificate. However, if such demand is made by the party or parties affected by
- the death, the coroner is authorized to hold the inquest; provided, further, that if such
- demand is made by any person having knowledge of the death and alleging elder abuse,
- the coroner is authorized to hold the inquest;"

18 SECTION 2.

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
