The Senate Committee on Judiciary offered the following substitute to HB 1165:

## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 35-6A-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
 membership, vacancies, and membership not bar to holding public office, so as to replace the
 chairperson of the Governor's Office of Children and Families with the commissioner of the
 Georgia Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities on the Criminal
 Justice Coordinating Council; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date;
 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

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## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

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## **SECTION 1.**

9 Code Section 35-6A-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to membership,
10 vacancies, and membership not bar to holding public office, is amended by revising
11 paragraph (1) of subsection (a) as follows:

12 "(1) The chairperson of the Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training Council, the 13 director of homeland security, the chairperson of the Judicial Council of Georgia, the 14 chairperson of the Council of Accountability Court Judges of Georgia, the chairperson 15 of the Prosecuting Attorneys' Council of the State of Georgia, the commissioner of 16 corrections, the chairperson of the Board of Corrections, the commissioner of community 17 supervision, the chairperson of the Board of Community Supervision, the vice chairperson of the Board of Public Safety, the chairperson of the State Board of Pardons 18 and Paroles, the State School Superintendent, the commissioner of community affairs, the 19 president of the Council of Juvenile Court Judges, the chairperson of the Georgia Public 20 21 Defender Council, the chairperson of the Governor's Office for Children and Families the commissioner of the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities, 22 23 and the commissioner of juvenile justice or their designees shall be ex officio members 24 of the council, as full voting members of the council by reason of their office; and" 25 **SECTION 2.** 

26 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law27 without such approval.

## 28 **SECTION 3.**

29 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
