A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 exemptions from sales and use taxes, so as to exempt sales of clothing and school related  
3 supplies during the last two weeks of July each year; to provide for related matters; to repeal  
4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from  
8 sales and use taxes, is amended by revising subparagraph (A) of paragraph (75) as follows:  
9 "(75)(A) The sale of eligible property. The exemption provided by this paragraph  
10 applies only to sales occurring during the period commencing at 12:01 A.M. on July 30,  
11 ~~2016~~, 18 and concluding at 12:00 Midnight on July 31, ~~2016~~ of each year."

12 **SECTION 2.**

13 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
