A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions regarding law enforcement officers and agencies, so as to prohibit the
- 3 possession of certain property from the United States Department of Defense by certain local
- 4 law enforcement agencies; to provide for a definition; to provide for related matters; to
- 5 provide for a short title; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

8 This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Stop Militarizing Law Enforcement Act."

9 SECTION 2.

- 10 Chapter 1 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 11 provisions regarding law enforcement officers and agencies, is amended by adding a new
- 12 Code section to read as follows:
- 13 <u>"35-1-23.</u>
- 14 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'law enforcement agency' means any agency,
- organ, or department of a political subdivision or municipality of this state whose primary
- 16 <u>functions include the enforcement of criminal or traffic laws; the preservation of public</u>
- order; the protection of life and property; or the prevention, detection, or investigation of
- crime, including, but not limited to, any department or unit organized by a college or
- 19 <u>university for purposes of Chapter 8 of Title 20.</u>
- 20 (b) No law enforcement agency shall accept possession of any of the following from the
- 21 <u>United States Department of Defense:</u>
- 22 (1) Controlled firearms, ammunition, grenades, or explosives, including, but not limited
- 23 <u>to, stun grenades and flash-bang grenades;</u>
- 24 (2) Controlled vehicles, highly mobile multi-wheeled vehicles, mine-resistant ambush
- 25 protected vehicles, trucks, truck sump, truck utility, or truck carryall;

- 26 (3) Unmanned aircraft that are armored or weaponized;
- 27 (4) Controlled aircraft that are combat configured or combat coded or have no
- 28 <u>established commercial flight application;</u>
- 29 (5) Silencers; or
- 30 (6) Long-range acoustic devices.
- 31 (c) Law enforcement agencies which do not comply with the requirements of this Code
- 32 section shall be subject to the withholding of any state funding or state administered federal
- 33 <u>funding.</u>"
- SECTION 3.

35 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
