BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
SECTION 1.
Code Section 35-8-7 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the powers and
duties of the Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training Council, is amended by revising
paragraph (20) as follows:
"(20) To establish as part of the curriculum for basic and in-service training courses for
all peace officers training on organized criminal activity, and criminal street gangs, and
post-traumatic stress disorder;"
SECTION 2.
This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
without such approval.
SECTION 3.
All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
