A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 15-6-30, relating to travel expenses of judges of the superior courts,
2 so as to transfer from the state auditor to The Council of Superior Court Judges of Georgia
3 duties related to review and approval of travel expenses; to provide for related matters; to
4 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 Code Section 15-6-30, relating to travel expenses of judges of the superior courts, is amended
8 by revising subsection (d) as follows:

9 "(d) The several judges of the superior courts shall, once a month, submit a detailed and
10 certified statement of the items of expense, as authorized by this Code section, ~~to the state~~
11 ~~auditor, and the state auditor is directed to audit each account and approve same for~~
12 ~~payment, if found correct, and to transmit the total amount to~~ The Council of Superior
13 Court Judges of Georgia for the review, approval, and processing of reimbursement
14 payment from the funds available for the operation of the superior courts of this state.
15 Senior judges of the superior courts shall, once a month, submit a detailed and certified
16 statement of the items of expense, as authorized by Code Sections 47-8-64 and 47-23-100,

17 ~~to the state auditor, and the state auditor is directed to audit each account and approve same~~
18 ~~for payment, if found correct, and to transmit the total amount to The Council of Superior~~
19 ~~Court Judges of Georgia for review, approval, and processing of reimbursement payment~~
20 ~~from the funds available for the operation of the superior courts of this state."~~
