A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 10 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to obstruction of public administration and related offenses, so as to provide a
- 3 definition; to prohibit any person from knowingly and willfully obstructing or hindering any
- 4 park ranger in the lawful discharge of such park ranger's official duties; to prohibit any
- 5 person from knowingly and willfully resisting, obstructing, or opposing any park ranger in
- 6 the lawful discharge of such park ranger's official duties by offering or doing violence to the
- 7 person of such park ranger; to provide for penalties; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 8 purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

- 11 Article 2 of Chapter 10 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 12 obstruction of public administration and related offenses, is amended by adding a new Code
- 13 section to read as follows:
- 14 "<u>16-10-24.4.</u>
- 15 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'park ranger' means any person, other than a law
- enforcement officer and other individuals covered under Code Section 16-10-24, however
- designated, who is employed by the state, any political subdivision of the state, or the
- 18 <u>United States for the enforcement of park rules and regulations.</u>
- 19 (b) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (c) of this Code section, a person who
- 20 <u>knowingly and willfully obstructs or hinders any park ranger in the lawful discharge of his</u>
- 21 <u>or her official duties shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.</u>
- 22 (c) Whoever knowingly and willfully resists, obstructs, or opposes any park ranger in the
- 23 <u>lawful discharge of his or her official duties by offering or doing violence to the person of</u>
- 24 <u>such park ranger shall be guilty of a felony and, upon conviction thereof, be punished by</u>
- 25 <u>imprisonment for not less than one nor more than five years."</u>

26 **SECTION 2.**

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed. 27
