A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 45-2-9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state
- 2 agencies not to discriminate in employment against servicemen's wives, so as to provide for
- 3 updated language regarding spouses of armed forces service members; to provide for related
- 4 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 45-2-9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state agencies
- 8 not to discriminate in employment against servicemen's wives, is amended as follows:

- 10 (a) No department, agency, or board of the state shall deny employment with such
- department, agency, or board to a wife whose husband person whose spouse is a service
- member on active duty in the armed forces of the United States or on active duty in a
- reserve component of the armed forces of the United States, including the national guard,
- merely because she is a wife he or she is the spouse of a member of the armed forces.
- 15 (b) This Code section shall not be construed to require a department, agency, or board of
- 16 the state to employ any person who is not qualified for such employment or to employ any

person if no opening is available for the position applied for by such person. This Code section is intended only to prevent departments, agencies, and boards of the state from discriminating against wives of servicemen spouses of service members in the opportunity of securing employment with such departments, agencies, and boards."
