A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 1 of Article 2 of Chapter 8 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to solid waste management, so as to regulate the surface storage and
- 3 disposal of coal combustion waste; to provide a definition; to provide for related matters; to
- 4 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Part 1 of Article 2 of Chapter 8 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 8 relating to solid waste management, is amended in Code Section 12-8-22, relating to solid
- 9 waste definitions, by redesignating paragraph (4.1) as paragraph (4.2) and adding a new
- 10 paragraph to read as follows:

- 11 "(4.1) 'Coal combustion waste' means any fly ash, bottom ash, or boiler slag generated
- as a result of the combustion of coal."

SECTION 2.

- 14 Said part is further amended in Code Section 12-8-24, relating to permits for solid waste
- 15 handling, by adding a new subsection (a.1) to read as follows:
- 16 "(a.1)(1) No person shall collect, store, or dispose of any coal combustion waste in any
- surface impoundment unless such person obtains a permit issued by the division. For
- purposes of this Code section, 'surface impoundment' means a pit, pond, or lagoon
- designed to contain liquid waste material and prevent its escape into the environment.
- 20 (2) As a condition of holding a permit under this Code section, an applicant shall:
- 21 (A) Demonstrate to the director's satisfaction that an adequate ground-water monitoring
- 22 <u>system has been implemented at the impoundment site;</u>
- 23 (B) Maintain financial assurance, approved by the director, sufficient to ensure
- 24 <u>compliance with this Code section; and</u>

25 (3) For any surface impoundment constructed after January 1, 2014, install a liner sufficient to protect ground water and underlying soil from leachate contamination."

SECTION 3.

28 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
