

House Bill 1392

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 33-1-24 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 insurance requirements for transportation network companies and their drivers, so as to
3 revise the minimum amounts of uninsured and underinsured motorist coverage to be
4 maintained by transportation network companies; to provide for related matters; to provide
5 for an effective date; to provide for applicability; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
6 purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Code Section 33-1-24 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to insurance
10 requirements for transportation network companies and their drivers, is amended by revising
11 subsection (b) as follows:

12 "(b) A transportation network company shall maintain or cause to be maintained a primary
13 motor vehicle insurance policy that:

14 (1) Recognizes the driver as a transportation network company driver and explicitly
15 covers the driver's provision of transportation network company services as defined in
16 paragraph (5) of subsection (a) of this Code section;

17 (2) During the time period defined in subparagraph (a)(5)(A) of this Code section,
18 provides a minimum of \$100,000.00 for bodily injuries to or death of all persons in any
19 one accident with a maximum of \$50,000.00 for bodily injuries to or death of one person
20 and \$50,000.00 for loss of or damage to property of others, excluding cargo, in any one
21 accident; and

22 (3) During the time period defined in subparagraph (a)(5)(B) of this Code section,
23 provides a minimum of \$1 million for death, personal injury, and property damage per
24 occurrence and provides uninsured and underinsured motorist coverage of at least \$1
25 million as required by ~~Code Section 33-7-11, with minimum limits of \$300,000.00 for~~
26 ~~bodily injuries to or death of all persons in any one accident with a maximum of~~
27 ~~\$100,000.00 for bodily injuries to or death of one person and \$25,000.00 for loss of or~~
28 ~~damage to property of others, excluding cargo, in any one accident."~~

29 **SECTION 2.**

30 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2024, and shall apply to causes of action accruing
31 on or after July 1, 2024.

32 **SECTION 3.**

33 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
