- 8 compensation, is amended in Code Section 17-15-8, relating to required findings, amount of
- 9 award, rejection of claim, reductions, exemptions, effective date for awards, psychological
- 10 counseling for relatives of deceased, and memorials for victims of DUI homicide, by adding
- 11 a new subsection to read as follows:
- 12 "(b.1)(1) Payments made by the board to medical service providers for compensation for
- medical services shall be made in accordance with the list of usual, customary, and
- reasonable charges for medical services published by the State Board of Workers'
- 15 Compensation as provided for in Code Section 34-9-205 unless an investigation of the

charges by the board determines that there is a reasonable health care justification for the

- deviation from such list of usual, customary, and reasonable charges.
- 18 (2) Payments made to and accepted by a medical provider shall be considered payment
- in full for the charges with respect to the board, victim, and claimant."
