## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to

2 holidays and observances, so as to designate April 29 of each year as "Heritage and Freedom

3 Flag of the Former Republic of Vietnam Day" in Georgia; to provide legislative findings; to

4 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

## **SECTION 1.**

7 The General Assembly finds that:

8 (1) The Former Republic of Vietnam was an ally of the United States of America during
9 the Vietnam War;

10 (2) South Vietnamese fled their homeland during the fall of Saigon on April 30, 1975,

11 many of those families making their home in this state;

12 (3) Since the end of the Vietnam War, Vietnamese Americans have contributed in ways

13 that affect all aspects of life in Georgia, including working as teachers, doctors, farmers,

small business owners, athletes, engineers, religious leaders, attorneys, and more;

15	(4) As it is important for future generations to understand the history of service between
16	the United States of America and South Vietnam during the Vietnam War, it is important
17	to recognize and honor the Vietnamese community in Georgia; and
18	(5) It is, therefore, abundantly fitting and proper that the State of Georgia appropriately
19	recognize and celebrate Vietnamese culture and tradition by designating April 29 of each
20	year as "Heritage and Freedom Flag of the Former Republic of Vietnam Day" in Georgia.
