- 8 Article 3 of Chapter 8 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 9 Long-term Care Ombudsman Program, is amended by revising Code Section 31-8-59,
- 10 relating to notice to residents, as follows:
- 11 "31-8-59.
- 12 (a) The state ombudsman shall prepare and distribute to each long-term care facility in the
- state a written notice describing the long-term care ombudsman program and the procedure
- to follow in making a complaint, including the address and telephone number of the state
- ombudsman and community ombudsman, if any. The administrator shall give the written
- notice required by this Code section subsection to each resident and his or her legally

appointed guardian, if any, upon admission. The administrator shall also post such written 17 notice in conspicuous public places in the facility in accordance with procedures provided 18 19 by the state ombudsman and shall give such notice to any resident and his or her legally appointed guardian, if any, who did not receive it upon admission. The failure to provide 20 21 the notices required by this Code section subsection shall be a ground upon which the department may revoke any permit issued to a long-term care facility under Code Section 22 31-7-1. 23 24 (b) Each individual long-term care facility which maintains a website shall post in a prominent location on such website, a weblink to the official website of the office of the 25 state long-term care ombudsman." 26

28 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
