A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act to provide a new charter for the City of Covington, approved May 6, 2019
- 2 (Ga. L. 2019, p. 4011), so as to change the corporate limits of such municipality; to provide
- 3 for related matters; to provide for a contingent effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and
- 4 for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 An Act to provide a new charter for the City of Covington, approved May 6, 2019
- 8 (Ga. L. 2019, p. 4011), is amended in Section 1.04 by designating the existing text as
- 9 subsection (a) and adding a new subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 10 "(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this charter to the contrary, the corporate
- limits of the City of Covington shall not include the following described property:
- All those tracts or parcels of land lying and being in Land Lots 270, 271, 287 and 288 of
- the 9th Land District, Newton County, Georgia, and being Lots 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11,
- per plat of survey for John Little Subdivision, prepared by Patrick and Associates, Inc.,
- Louie D. Patrick, GA RLS No. 1757, dated 09/24/07, recorded 10/23/07 at Plat Book 47,
- Pages 217-220, Newton County, Georgia records.

Said properties respectively being now known as 9101, 9121, 9131, and 9141 Aaron Drive, and 7101, 7111, and 7135 Keegan Court, Oxford, Georgia 30054, and formerly known as 9101, 9121, 9131, and 9141 Aaron Drive, and 7101, 7111, and 7135 Keegan Court, Covington, Georgia 30014, in accordance with the current system of numbering houses in Newton County, Georgia."

SECTION 2.

This Act shall become effective on the first day of the month following the month in which it is approved by the Governor or becomes law without such approval, provided that an Act annexing the territory described in this Act into the City of Oxford is enacted in the 2024 session of the General Assembly.

SECTION 3.

28 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
