## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 15 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to serious traffic offenses, so as to require that persons convicted of driving under
- 3 the influence reimburse the jurisdiction that incurred the costs of drawing and testing the
- 4 person's blood; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date and
- 5 applicability; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 15 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 serious traffic offenses, is amended in Code Section 40-6-391, relating to driving under the
- 10 influence of alcohol, drugs, or other intoxicating substances, penalties, publication of notice
- 11 of conviction for persons convicted for second time, and endangering a child, by adding a
- 12 new subsection to read as follows:

- 13 "(m) When a person is convicted of violating this Code section, the sentencing court shall
- require, as a part of the person's sentence, that the person make restitution for the costs of
- testing such person's blood to the governmental entity that incurred such costs, including
- the cost of drawing such blood and performing the chemical analysis of such blood."

17 SECTION 2.

- 18 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2022, and shall apply to all crimes occurring on
- 19 or after such date.

20 SECTION 3.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
