A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 34 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,  
2 relating to medical practice, so as to repeal requirements for advertising or publicizing of  
3 medical specialty certification; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and  
4 for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 Article 2 of Chapter 34 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
8 medical practice, is amended by repealing Code Section 43-34-22.1, relating to requirements  
9 for advertising or publicizing of medical specialty certification.

11 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
